Students

On-Campus Recruitment

The high schools of the school district shall provide the same directory information and on-campus recruiting opportunities to representatives of the armed forces of the United States of America and State Armed Services as are offered to post-graduate non-military recruiters, institutions of higher learning, and representatives of commercial concerns.

The District will inform, students and parents/guardians at the middle and high school levels, of the availability of (1) vocational, technical and technological education and training at technical high schools, and (2) agricultural sciences and technology education at regional agricultural science and technology education centers.

Military recruiters or institutions of higher learning shall have access to secondary school students' names, addresses, and telephone listings unless a secondary school student, 18 years of age or older or the parent of the student requests that such information not be released without prior written parental consent. The District shall notify parents and students of the option to make such request and shall comply with any request received.

The District shall also provide full access for the recruitment of students by technical high schools, regional agricultural science and technology education centers, inter-district magnet schools, charter schools and inter-district student programs, provided such recruitment is not for the purpose of interscholastic athletic competition. The District shall also post information about these school options on its website.
