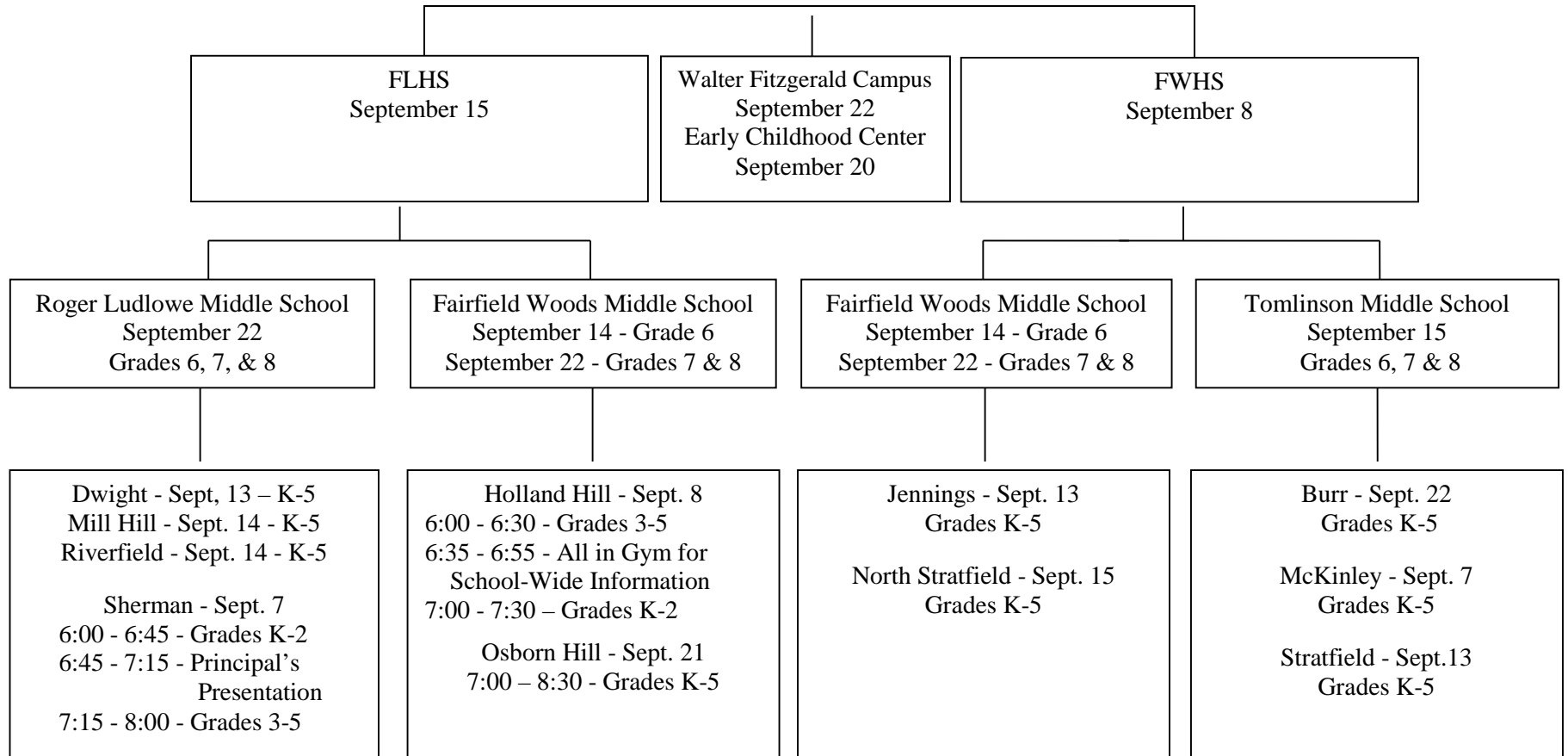

- I. Chairman Jennifer Maxon-Kennelly called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. Mr. Anthony Calabrese was in attendance. Dr. Title and Mr. Cummings attended on behalf of the administration.
- II. April 18, 2016 Meeting Minutes. Approved 2-0.
- III. Policy
 - ♦ **Policy 5144.4** - Students – Discipline, Physical Exercise and Discipline of Students, **Mandated** Policy Recommended by CABE
Approved for First Reading at the May 17 BOE Meeting: 2-0
 - ♦ **Policy 5145.511** - Students – Exploitation, Sexual Abuse Prevention and Education Program, **Mandated** Policy Recommended by CABE
Included with the policy is a document entitled “Sexual Abuse Prevention and Education Program (Erin’s Law)” to provide background information for legislation and policy.

Amendments as follows:

5145.511(a)

1. Update the date in 3rd paragraph titled “Program” to October 1, 2016.
2. Change all first words in bullets to lower case and add semi-colons at the end of each bullet.

5145.511(b)

1. Under #2, first paragraph, add the words “instructional and” after age-appropriate.
2. Under #2, change all first words in bullets to lower case and add semi-colons at the end of each bullet, except for the last one (f).
3. In the second paragraph, starting with “The Board of Education” add the word “to” after Superintendent.
4. In the third paragraph, replace “)” with a period at the end of the sentence.

5145.511(c)

1. Use correct policy title in First Paragraph
2. In last paragraph, last sentence, replace policy number with in policy “Reporting of Child Abuse and Neglect.”
3. Add the new Legal Reference for Professional Conduct

Policy 4400 should be placed as a First Read for Deletion at the May 17 meeting: 2-0
Policy 5517 should be recodified.

Approved as amended for First Reading at the May 17 BOE Meeting: 2-0

- ♦ **Policy 6121** – Instruction – Nondiscrimination in the Instructional Program
Mandated Policy Recommended by CABE

Amendments as follows:

Add semi-colons at end of bullets 1-4, add semi-colon and the word “and” to bullet #5.

Approved as amended for First Reading at the May 17 BOE Meeting: 2-0

- ♦ **Policy 6171.2** – Instruction – Special Education, Preschool Education
Mandated Policy Recommended by CABE

Included with policy is a document entitled “Preschool Special Education” to provide background information for legislation and policy

Dr. Title confirmed with CABE that this is a mandated policy.

Approved for First Reading at the May 17 BOE Meeting: 2-0
