### **Rights, Responsibilities, and Duties**

#### **SMOKING BY SCHOOL EMPLOYEES**

4220

In Accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, and with Board Policy, smoking or any other use of tobacco, tobacco products, including chewing tobacco or tobacco paraphernalia will not be permitted in any public school building, on school grounds, in school vehicles, or at any school-related event in the Town of Fairfield. For purposes of this policy, "use of tobacco" shall mean all uses of tobacco, including but not limited to: cigarettes; cigars; electronic vapor cigarettes; snuff; blunts; bidis; pipes; chewing tobacco; any inhalant that contains tobacco or nicotine; all other forms of smokeless tobacco or devices that produce the same flavor or physical effect of nicotine substances; rolling papers; any other items containing or reasonably resembling tobacco or tobacco products; and, any other tobacco or nicotine innovations.

**SMOKING**

**5314**

In Accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, and with Board Policy, smoking or any other use or possession of tobacco, tobacco products, including chewing tobacco or tobacco paraphernalia by students will not be permitted in any public school building, on school grounds, in school vehicles, or at any school-related event in the Town of Fairfield. For purposes of this policy, "use or possession of tobacco" shall mean all uses of tobacco, including but not limited to: cigarettes; cigars; electronic vapor cigarettes; snuff; blunts; bidis; pipes; chewing tobacco; any inhalant that contains tobacco or nicotine; all other forms of smokeless tobacco or devices that produce the same flavor or physical effect of nicotine substances; rolling papers; any other items containing or reasonably resembling tobacco or tobacco products; any other tobacco or nicotine innovations.
