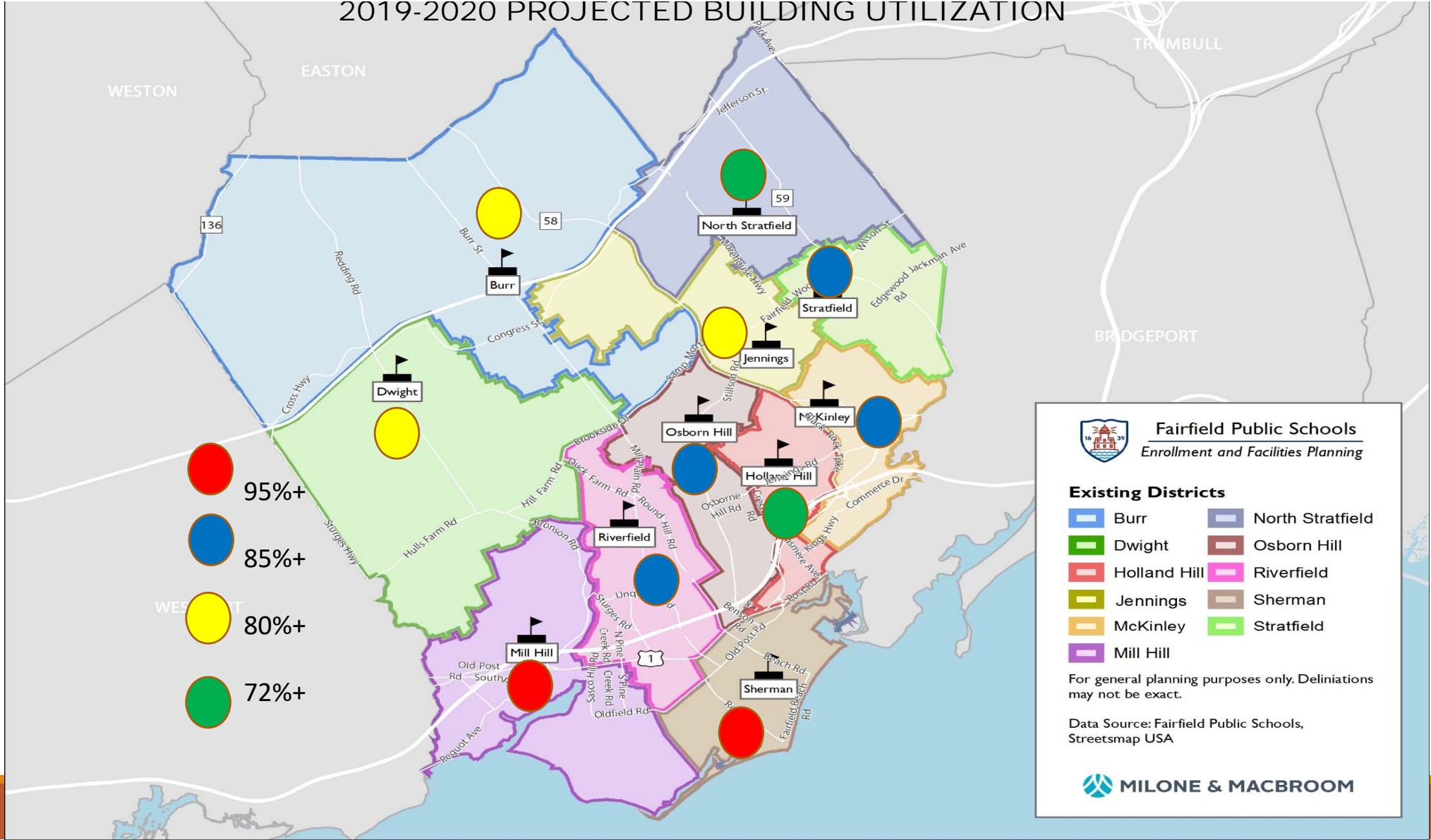

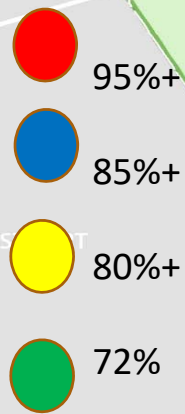

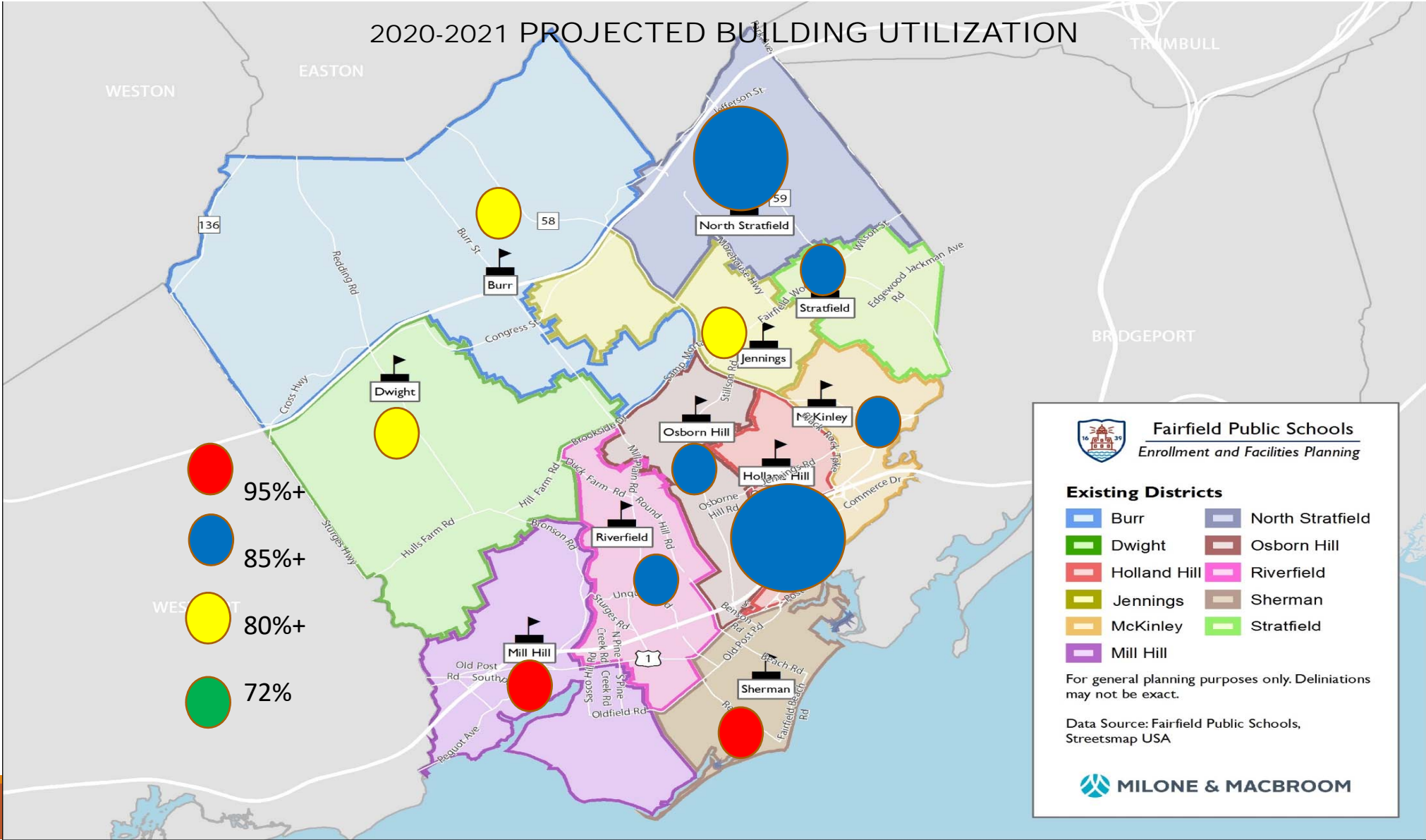

Program Goals for 2019-2020

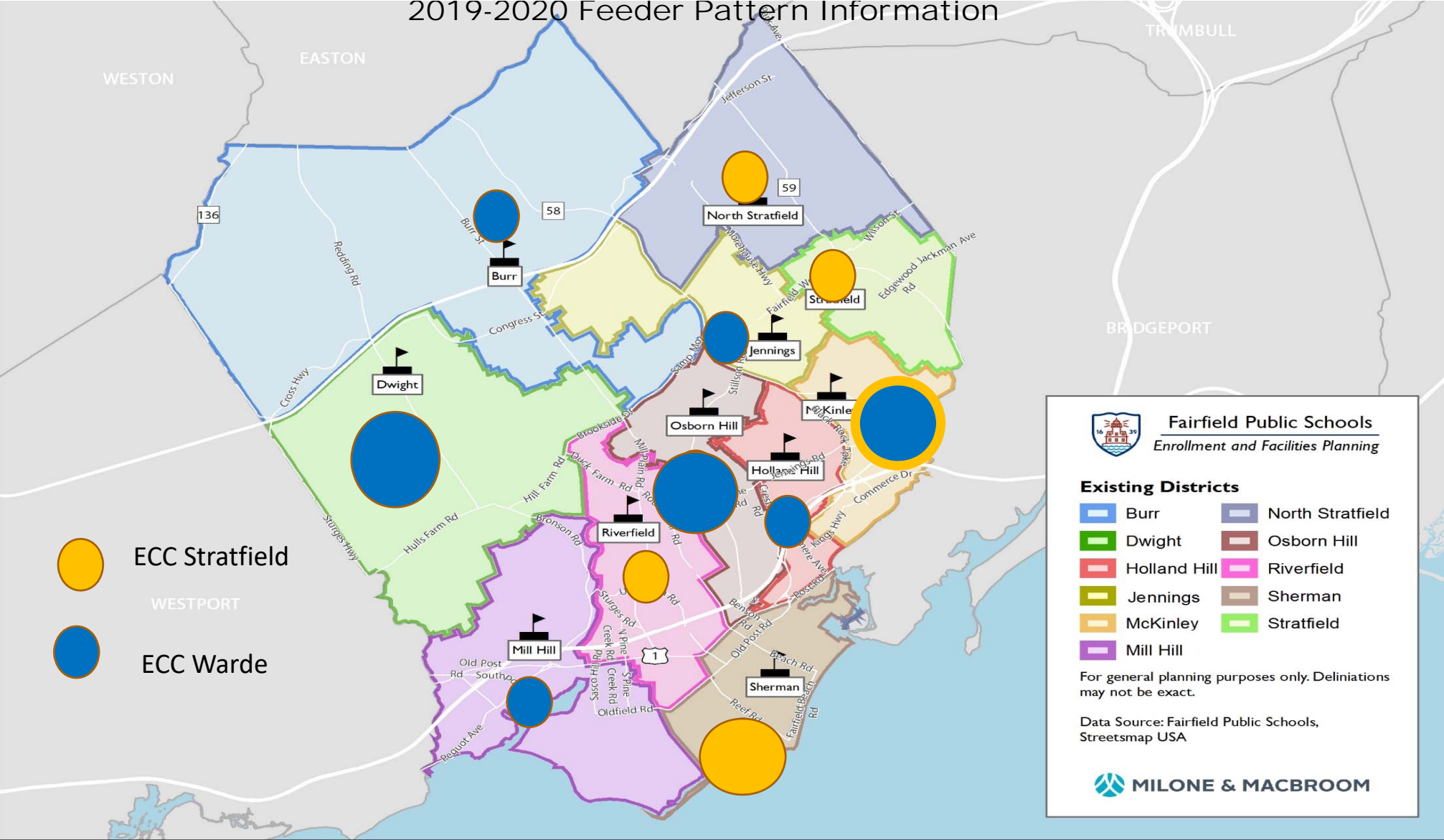
1. Class sizes of 15 (11.3 to start)
2. Peer to Peer Ratios Goal: 50/50 Minimum: 60% Special Needs/40%
**2018-2019 Peer Ratio Average was 27.5% in October and 23% in April
3. Balanced English Language Learners across both PK sites
4. Improve PK to Kindergarten Transition (program focus)
5. Seats Available for Growth
6. Feeder pattern transitions
