Within the school setting, some differentiation of the curriculum shall occur for efficient and effective instruction. As a result, students may choose or be assigned to instructional groups that emphasize challenging learning activities appropriate to the current instructional levels of the students within the group. The differentiation in learning objectives for these instructional groups shall be made available upon request.

The goal of these practices is to promote a developmental approach to skill improvement. Therefore, the staff shall regularly reassess the appropriateness of the instructional groups. The appropriate administrative staff in consultation with the parent or guardian and student involved shall review questions relative to placement.
