Overview

The central focus of APGov summer reading is to examine the role the U.S. Constitution plays in American government and politics today. Government and Politics students will start their summer reading by studying the U.S. Constitution. Students will also read national political news on a daily basis throughout the summer. During six of the nine weeks of summer vacation, students will write analyses connecting their current event articles to the U.S. Constitution and U.S. government/politics curricular questions. One analysis must be submitted per week to turnitin.com over six of the nine weeks of summer.

U.S. Government and Politics Curricular Question Sets

Students will address <u>six</u> question sets below. Each of the six analyses will address a different question set. Question sets will direct news article selection. Students should read several articles related to each topic before composing their analyses. Analyses, each approximately 500 words in length, will integrate both current events and U.S. constitutional provisions.

- 1. Is the system of checks and balances set up in Articles I III of the U.S. Constitution effective at balancing and limiting the powers of the legislative, executive, and judicial branches of the federal government?
- 2. Select three bills or laws which have been considered by the 113th U.S. Congress. How does each piece of legislation connect to the powers granted to Congress in Article I Section 8 of the U.S. Constitution? Have the executive and judicial branches been involved in the creation of policy in these areas?
- 3. The U.S. Supreme Court is the highest court of the land. Select a case adjudicated in the past calendar year. Which constitutional principles were considered and from which perspectives? Evaluate the impact the decision may have on policy. What impact could concurring or dissenting opinions have on future cases?
- 4. Judicial Activism is the idea that courts can extend beyond their role of interpreting law and engage in the creation of new policy. Find and analyze an example of the U.S. Supreme Court engaging in judicial activism within the last year. Can you find a basis for or against judicial activism in Article III of the U.S. Constitution?
- 5. Although the U.S. Constitution does not address or provide for political parties, these organizations wield great power in the U.S. government. Analyze news articles in which the activity of a political party is instrumental in shaping our government policy or legislation. Which part of the U.S. Constitution enables political parties to play a role in government?
- 6. The Supreme Court has ruled that campaign donations may be considered a form of political speech protected by the First Amendment. Locate news sources which identify the sources of candidates' campaign donations. Hypothesize the effects these funds could have on the upcoming midterm election and a politician's behavior.
- 7. Describe federalism and the relationship between federal and state powers. Which aspects of the U.S. Constitution provide the framework for this relationship? Describe one conflict between federal and state powers in the news this year, and how Americans are impacted.
- 8. Media plays a large role in filtering and highlighting the general public's focus on current events. Evaluate the role media plays in agenda-setting for the public and the government. How do the media prime our view of politicians and frame our view of events/policies? How essential is the freedom of the press?
- 9. How do interest groups, bureaucratic agencies, and congressional committees (also known as iron triangles or issue networks) work to create and influence public policy? Do you think the founding fathers would have predicted this relationship? Do you believe these networks are elitist or pluralist?
- 10. The President and Congress have delegated power to the federal bureaucracy. Track the implementation of a federal policy by the bureaucracy. Has the U.S. Congress exercised oversight over the process? How involved is the President? Why do you think the bureaucracy has been given a lot of discretion in administering policy?
