DDS (Department of Developmental Disabilities)
DSS(Department of Social Services)
BRS Bureau of Rehabilitation Services,
SSA(Social Security Administration)

Are all state and or federal agencies charged with helping individuals with disabilities get the support they need to be a functioning member of society.
