Transportation	Transportation is provided as a related service to students receiving special education services at ECC or Stratfield. Free transportation will be provided for current students who qualify for Reduced or Free tuition. Parents/guardians can request transportation on a fee based system. The cost will be an additional \$400.00 per month.	
Tuition	<u>2019 – 2020 Tuition Rates</u> <i>Tuition determination is based on household income</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full Tuition = \$4,571.00/year • Reduced Tuition = \$2,316.00/year Free Tuition also available for those who qualify • Students may be withdrawn if late payments exceed 60 days 	
Deposit Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For students who qualify for full or reduced tuition a 1-month tuition deposit is required at the time of acceptance (\$457.00 for full tuition and \$232.00 for reduced tuition). • Deposits are not refundable after April 1, 2019 – no exceptions made. 	
Admission & Placement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admission will occur on a rolling basis • Placement will be made as space is available • Placement will be made in order to best balance classrooms • Each class session is made up of a combination of 3- and 4-year old students • Students who do not attend school for 10 or more consecutive days due to an <u>unexcused</u> absence may forfeit their placement if sections are full. 	
Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-year olds (must be 3 by December 31, 2019) Students start on or after their 3rd birthday • 4-year olds (must be 4 by December 31, 2019) • 3-year old students may remain in the program as 4-year old students the following year • Students must be toilet trained to start 	
Curriculum & Assessment	The Fairfield Board of Education Preschool Curriculum identifies what students will learn and be able to do. Developmentally appropriate assessments given throughout the school year measure how students are progressing toward achieving key curriculum standards.

- **ECC Stratfield: Osborn Hill, Riverfield, Dwight, Stratfield and North Stratfield**
