



Program Goals for 2019-2020

- 1. Class sizes of 15 (11.3 to start)
- 2. Peer to Peer Ratios Goal: 50/50 Minimum: 60% Special Needs/40%
- **2018-2019 Peer Ratio Average was 27.5% in October and 23% in April
- 3. Balanced English Language Learners across both PK sites
- 4. Improve PK to Kindergarten Transition (program focus)
- 5. Seats Available for Growth
- 6. Feeder pattern transitions

Stratfield is zoned Stratfield

Holland Hill is zoned Warde ECC for Movement (When ECC Warde moves to HH)

NSS zoned Stratfield for Movement (When NSS site opens up)

PK-12+ Focus in Utilization

PK is being relocated into the elementary schools to resolve overcrowding at the ECC Warde site (virtually a small elementary of 172 children and growing)

Warde High School capacity is for 1,400 students

Warde High School is currently 1,479 students enrolled *Over Capacity

Warde can reclaim space when ECC is located at the elementary
