In compliance with Federal and State Law, all Board of Education meetings are public meetings and every effort shall be made to encourage citizens to attend.

When matters of personnel, litigation, negotiations, security, and/or real estate are to be discussed, the Board may recess to Executive Session.

Copies of the agenda and non-confidential enclosures for all Board meetings will be made available for public inspection in all the public libraries in the Town of Fairfield. Agenda and enclosures also will be displayed at all meetings of the Board.

The Board upon the recommendation of the Superintendent will make all appointments of citizens and staff members to advisory committees. The Board encourages representation from all appropriate Town bodies.
