The Fairfield Public Schools may participate in the National School Lunch Program. Authorization is granted to the Superintendent of Schools or designee to act on behalf of the Board for purposes of participating in this program. All applicable state and federal guidelines will be followed.

The Supervisor of Food Services shall be designated as the official who will review applications and make determinations of eligibility. The Director of Operations will hear appeals when a parent or guardian is dissatisfied with the administration's decision.

The Supervisor of Food Services shall send a letter outlining the eligibility criteria and a form on which to make application for free meals to the parent or guardian of children who may be eligible. This shall be done at the beginning of each school year and whenever there is a change in eligibility criteria.
