ASSIGNMENTS OF STUDENTS TO SCHOOLS

5122

Each public school student shall be assigned to attend a school based on attendance areas designated by the Board of Education. The student's assigned school will be one of the following:

- a geographically zoned school determined by the residence of the student's parent or guardian; or
- in the case of an emancipated minor (18 years of age and living independently), a geographically zoned school determined by the residence of the student.

The Board shall designate the boundaries of geographic zones controlling school assignments, and also the feeder pattern controlling assignments to the middle and high schools, based on the recommendations of the Superintendent.
