Instruction

SUMMER SCHOOL

Summer school instruction may be provided in the areas of remediation, creative arts and enrichment, or advanced study. Tuition may be charged for all summer school programs. The administration shall conduct the summer school program in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, in that the aggregate of summer school fees shall not exceed the cost of such program, except that the Board of Education may, at its discretion, waive charges for any individual student for any good and sufficient reason.

Review

The administration may conduct a summer program for students in need of a review of previously studied curriculum, or for those desiring to strengthen themselves in the basic skills.

Creative Arts

The administration may conduct a summer program for those desiring improvement in the skills in the creative arts areas, or those interested in acquiring a greater appreciation of the arts.

Advanced Studies Program

The administration may conduct a summer program for the academically talented students who are interested in acquiring more knowledge and skills in the basic subjects at an accelerated pace.
