## ADULT AND CONTINUING EDUCATION

6200

The Board encourages an adult and continuing education program that is rich, stimulating, and diverse, and provides enhancement experiences for the entire community. Classes in adult and continuing education shall be provided according to Connecticut General Statutes.

Residents of the Town of Fairfield and others will be charged registration and course fees established annually by the Board except as provided below:

- No registration fee will be charged to handicapped adults as defined by the State Board of Education.
- No registration fee will be charged to enrollees in adult basic elementary, secondary, or English as a Second Language courses.
- A reduced registration fee may be charged to senior citizens sixty-two (62) years of age or older.
