Dear Concerned Parties;

This letter is to inform you that there will be an asbestos abatement project at Jennings Elementary School located at 31 Palm Drive, in Fairfield, CT beginning on July 27, 2015. The abatement project includes the removal and disposal of pipe insulation, breeching and boiler insulation from the Boiler Room.

The abatement contractor will be AAIS and AMC Environmental, LLC will be the on-site consultant. The abatement will take place while there are no kids in the building.

AMC Environmental, LLC will be on site for full time monitoring during the abatement performing visual inspections and conducting daily air monitoring. All air samples collected during this asbestos abatement project will be analyzed on a daily basis by a laboratory certified by the DPH.

Upon completion of abatement in each area, re-occupancy clearance air samples will be obtained to assure that the State of Connecticut -Department of Public Health's re-occupancy criteria have been met.
