Scheduling:

Summer Adventures Camp will run two sessions: Session I — July 1 — July 12 and Session II — July 15 — July 26. Students can attend the Summer Adventures Camp for two weeks or four weeks. Courses will run for 1 hour. As you complete the registration form, be sure to schedule at least six courses for each session in the event that some courses close due to minimum/maximum enrollment requirements. The Instructional Office will use this information to develop your child's schedule. Schedules will be mailed to your home in early June. At registration, please be sure to include any material fees as indicated in the brochure. Course and material fees are to be paid in full at the time of registration.
